Let's Talk Technical

Higher horsepower? If your truck is putting out over 400 horsepower, the exhaust system may give you a marginal increase.

Lower EGTs? Less restriction out of the engine will be beneficial, and the ANSA exhaust system is less restrictive. Like fuel mileage claims, "Your mileage (results) may vary".

Great sound? In a word, YES!

Long life components? Yes, ANSA uses T409 stainless steel.

Aluminized steel? Aluminized steel is a heavy-gauge steel that has been offered as the solution for the cost-conscious consumer. Is it not a stainless steel grade material. This type of system is a viable option if you live in a salt-free Southern or Southwestern location. The original factory exhaust system on your truck was likely aluminized steel. Expect an equal service life.

Buyer's Guide: Exhaust System

T304 Stainless Steel? It is highly durable. It never rusts. It is the highest material grade and has the highest price point. T304 exhaust systems are typically 16-gauge stainless steel composed of 18-20% chromium and 8-10% nickel. T304 can be polished, and this material is used for vehicles in extreme weather conditions, for show vehicles, or for the truck owner that is willing to pay for a top-of-the-line exhaust system.

T409 Stainless Steel? T409 is the most widely used "stainless" in the exhaust system and accessories marketplace. It is a low carbon steel that is at least 12% chromium. In extreme weather it can show external wear and surface rust, but the interior will remain solid. It is presented in a wide range of finishes, from dull, to semi-polished, to polished.
