

Installation: A-Pillar Repair Kit

DODGE Trucks ('03-'09)



1) Remove Plastic caps with a flat blade screw driver revealing the hidden bolts.

2) Remove the two bolts with a 10mm socket.



3) PASSENGER SIDE: Slide the two larger bushings over the stock plastic mount (this is what breaks)

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

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- 4) Insert the two bolts into the smaller bushing and then into A-pillar trim and tighten.
- 5) Insert plastic caps.



6) DRIVER'S SIDE: You must first trim back the tabs which are protruding from the area in which the larger bushings slides over. This can be done with a pair of side cutters, grinder or file.



7) Slide the two larger bushings over the stock plastic mount (this is what breaks)

- 8) Insert the two bolts into the smaller bushing and then into A-pillar trim and tighten.
- 9) Insert the plastic caps.

Congratulations, you've just made your vehicle safer to enter and exit.
